Total indicative budget is **three million Euros** of which two million is allocated for enterprises engaged in **production**, and **one million for those providing services**.*

Objective Contribution to the growth and development of micro and small enterprises (MSEs) in the regions of Šumadija and Western Serbia and Southern and Eastern Serbia

Eligibility Criteria

Entrepreneurs, micro and small enterprises engaged in production and provision of services, registered between 1 January 2016 and 31 December 2020 in one of 99 local self-governments included in the Programme.

Procurement of new equipment and introduction of services for enterprises will contribute to the improvement of their production and market potential, value chain, as well as technological and digital transformation, greening of business and job creation while increasing the resilience of enterprises to recover from the negative impact of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Corporate social responsible activities that contribute to local communities are a mandatory part of all project proposals approved for funding.

* Supported services include Information Technology, architectural and engineering services, health care and social protection services, tourism related services, maintenance and repair services.
