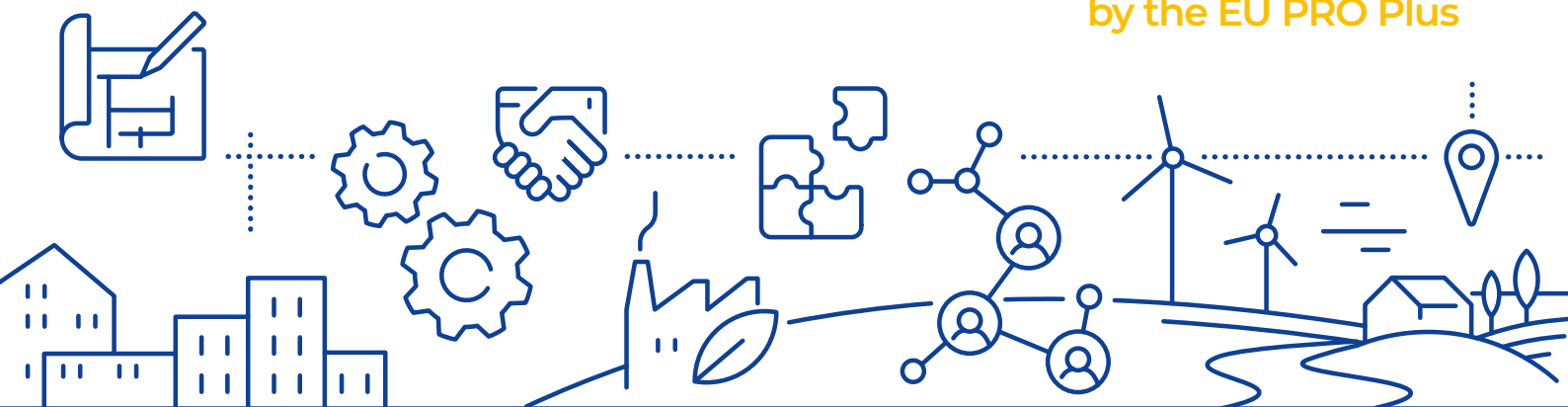

It includes establishing an organisational entity for cultural heritage management and developing a preservation and valorisation plan for the entire urban area. The initiative will equip the centre for workshops on the circular economy in art, aiming to engage over 1,000 individuals and benefit a community of over 265,000. By blending historical preservation with innovative education, the project aims to enhance the cultural identity and accessibility of Kragujevac and the Šumadijski district, promoting appreciation of its industrial legacy.</p>

LESKOVAC	<p>Improvement of the waste management system in the urban area of Leskovac with more advanced and innovative environmentally friendly solutions - PRO WASTE INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS</p> <p>PARTNERS: PC "Urbanism and construction" Leskovac, Academy of Professional Studies South Serbia, CSO Connector Leskovac</p>	<p>Total value 467,804 €</p> <p>EU 360,392 €</p> <p>Total value 107,011 €</p>	<p>Introduction of underground containers and advanced collection technologies in Leskovac to tackle waste segregation and capacity issues. The project envisages installation of 22 containers, employing an ecological vehicle, and utilising sensors and GIS for monitoring. A portable X-ray fluorescence (XRF) device will be procured to enhance waste analysis, supporting recycling efforts. The initiative will also include an awareness campaign and a zero-waste app, aiming to educate over 3,600 students and city employees. By streamlining waste processing and improving hygiene, the project aims to foster a cleaner, more sustainable environment for the entire community.</p>

NOVI PAZAR	<p>Improving the management of recyclable waste on the territory of the city of Novi Pazar</p> <p>PARTNER: Public utility company "Gradska čistoća" Novi Pazar</p>	<p>Total value 502,426 €</p> <p>EU 371,382 €</p> <p>Co-funding 131,044 €</p>	<p>Enhancing the capacity of the Recycling Centre for textile waste management and supporting the recycling ecosystem's technical needs to address the textile waste problem in the city. By upgrading facilities, acquiring a specialised transport vehicle, and integrating educational components through the School of Textile and Leather Design and community workshops on waste separation, the initiative promotes circular economy practices. The project envisages that over 100,000 residents would benefit, including industry employees, students, and informal waste pickers, while highlighting its broad environmental and educational impact.</p>

The project includes restoring and improving energy efficiency at Pirot Grammar School, making ergonomic improvements at high and primary schools in Bela Palanka, procuring specialised preschool furniture and learning tools for Dimitrovgrad school, and establishing open learning and recreational areas at Babušnica primary school. The initiative aims to enrich the learning environment and educational accessibility for over 2,000 students and teachers, benefiting nearly 3,000 community members and contributing to a sustainable response to depopulation and ageing.</p>

Zlatibor Regional Development Agency	<p>Green and energy transition in the Užice ITI territory</p> <p>PARTNERS: Užice, Čajetina, Bajina Bašta, Požega</p>	<p>Total value 1,678,069 €</p> <p>EU 1,307,927 €</p> <p>Co-funding 370,142 €</p>	<p>Introduction of solar installations and green solutions across public buildings and spaces to enhance energy efficiency and environmental rejuvenation. The project includes solar power plants, green roofs, and vertical gardens at key sites such as the National Theatre in Užice, the Regional Training Centre for Dual Education, a sports hall in Bajina Bašta, the Agricultural School in Požega, and the office building of Communal Public Enterprise "Zlatibor". The initiative aims to significantly reduce the area's carbon footprint and includes educational programmes and capacity-building activities to embed sustainable practices within the community. By benefiting over 110,000 citizens, the project fosters a broad understanding of green transitions and demonstrates the tangible benefits of integrating renewable energy into public infrastructure.</p>

The project includes refurbishing and activating ateliers and casemates, along with the active protection and promotion of cultural heritage and the cultural trail of the Tabula Peutingeriana (Peutinger Table). This trail connects historical and cultural sites across Niš and surrounding areas such as Svrljig, Merošina, and Gadžin Han, supported by new informational points and a cohesive promotional strategy. The initiative aims to enhance urban identity, attract tourists, and benefit over 50,000 people, enriching community engagement and cultural appreciation.</p>

BOR	<p>Ecosystem for innovation and smart economy in Bor</p> <p>PARTNER: RARIS - Regional development agency Eastern Serbia</p>	<p>Total value 305,324 €</p> <p>EU 242,116 €</p> <p>Co-funding 63,208 €</p>	<p>Enhancing economic diversification in a local economy dominated by the mining industry. The project supports entrepreneurship by establishing a Startup Centre with two rural points in Zlot and Gornjane, introducing a Living Lab and a Digital Platform for a smart economy. It also includes infrastructural upgrades like smart systems and energy efficiency measures for the Business Incubator Centre Bor. The initiative directly supports 20 SMEs and will train 75 individuals, fostering a more diversified and resilient local economy.</p>

The project includes developing tourism and recreational facilities in Zaječar, Knjaževac, Sokobanja, and Boljevac, with an emphasis on eco-friendly practices such as electric boats and bikes. Key initiatives are the construction and furnishing of a Youth Camp in Kraljevica Forest Park, Zaječar, the further development of the Sports-Recreational and Health-Rehabilitation Centre "Banjica" in Knjaževac, and construction at Bovan Lake in Sokobanja, including acquiring electric power boats. It also includes building a "Pump Track" training ground and trim track, procuring electric scooters and mountain bikes in Rtanj, and installing tourist signage in Boljevac. The project will establish management structures for new attractions, a common tourist card for the whole territory, and a territorial marketing strategy to enhance the area's visibility as a green tourism destination. This initiative aims to enrich the Zaječarski district's tourist offer, promoting environmental sustainability and local cultural heritage, benefiting communities and attracting visitors.</p>

This facility will also host cultural events, promoting interculturality and community engagement. Health assessments and tailored physical education programmes will be provided by a specialised team, benefiting students, parents, and over 100 educational professionals. This initiative represents a significant step towards improving youth well-being and fostering community integration in Šabac.</p>

The project includes infrastructure improvements, first aid training, and youth workshops, aiming to train 80 first aid trainers and engage 3,000 youngsters. Benefiting approximately 78,000 residents, this initiative seeks to invigorate the city's sports offerings and strengthen community safety and emergency responsiveness.</p>

The project includes constructing the "Risovača Cave" Visitor-Educational Centre in Arandelovac, reconstructing the King's Winery in Topola, renovating the House of Culture in Borač in Knić, and arranging Petrovi dvori in Viševac (Rača). By equipping these sites with advanced technology, the initiative aims to improve tourism infrastructure. Emphasis is placed on staff training and developing new tourism products to enrich the visitor experience. The project aims to attract more visitors and benefit the local economy, directly impacting 1,500 professionals and indirectly serving over 80,000 people, transforming the region into a distinguished tourism destination.</p>
